Dear Praying Women of the Worldwide Prayer Web,

As you meditate on Deuteronomy 17:18, do you sense that this is God's requirement for the head of every nation for all time to be immersed in His Law while making decisions? As you meditate on Matthew 10:18, do you sense that God intends for His disciples to testify to government officials? As you meditate on Luke 10:23-24, can you sense that there is a special work of God in the life of every government official to cause them to hunger for God? Why, if government officials are so hungry to know God if not the hungriest, is government such an ungodly institution? Is it because we in the Body of Christ do not fulfill our God-given responsibility? Every year, late in September for a few days, 100 heads of nations (Presidents, Prime Ministers, Kings, Amirs) travel to New York for the opening of the annual United Nations meeting. In addition, 180 Foreign Ministers, typically the second or third most influential person in the nation, are here at the same time. Many of these officials are from nations where they could not hear about Jesus in their own culture or follow Him. Could this not be a strategic opportunity for the Body of Christ to reach these leaders for Jesus while they are in the United States? These leaders will be in New York between September 21st and October 1st.

Would you join us in praying that God will open doors to minister to these strategic individuals?

And in our own country, what chaos and confusion exist as we watch the political scene, hear the political jargon, notice the duplicity and manipulation of our times....our comfort and security lies only in knowing that "Promotion comes from the Lord. He it is who puts one man up and another man down" Psalm 75, especially verses 6 and 7....let us speak to God about the matter, and trust Him...as we pray for revival and an awakening in the United States...as we look to God alone, reminding ourselves that we are citizens of a different country...Eph. 2: read the chapter and note verse 19....Pray, Pray, Pray.....Lois E.
